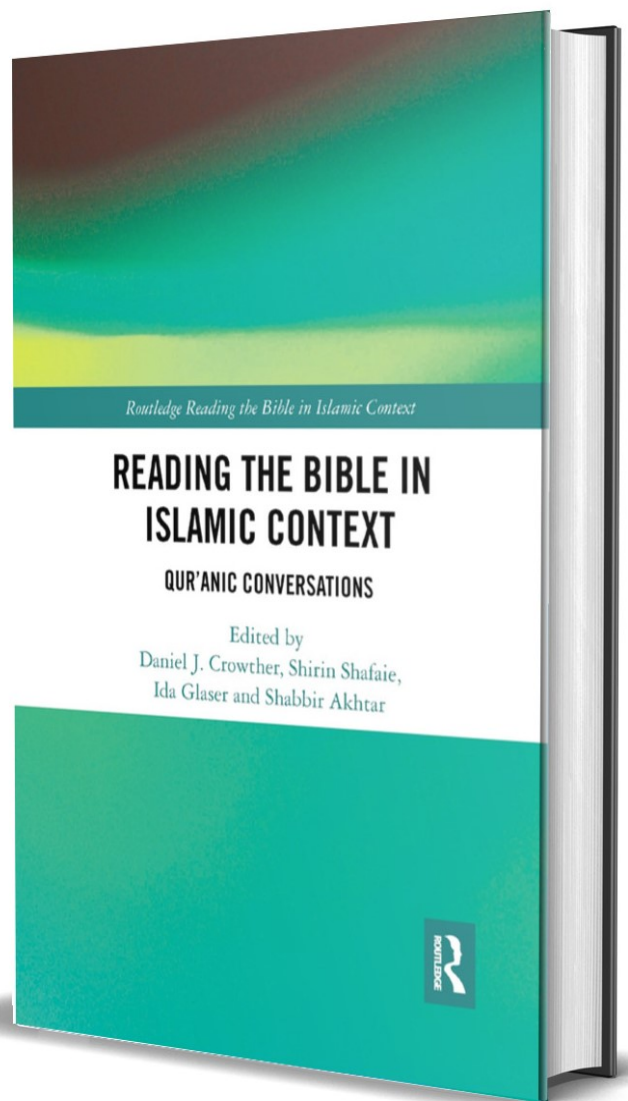
Paul's Letter to the Galatians
